Students entering all Western Engineering programs must have completed the entire first year program in Engineering, with no outstanding credits to be taken. Applicants achieving these minima are not guaranteed acceptance into a particular program.

Software	> 60%	Applicants are required to have a minimum of 60% in NMM 1411A/B, NMM 1412A/B, NMM 1414A/B and ES 1036A/B and a Year 1 Average (YWA) 60%.
