

Intent to Register

Are you planning to return to Western in September, 2023?

YES: submit your **Intent to Register** to access web registration in the summer to register for Fall/Winter courses.

If you don't submit your **Intent to Register**, you will not have access to the web registration system.

Web registration begins mid-July – you will be notified of the date on your UWO email *if* you've completed your Intent to Register

Intent to Register March 1st – March 31st

STEP 1: READ the Academic Calendar for:

- graduation & program requirements
- course requisites (pre-, co- and anti-requisites)

STEP 2: ATTEND a virtual information session or seek department counselling for:

- questions about the program
- courses or course selection process for the upcoming year

STEP 3: COMPLETE and **SUBMIT** your <u>Intent to Register</u> by 4:00 P.M. on **March 31, 2023**
